The antenna is at an elevation of approx. 1050 feet msl. Each Sunday evening at 21:00 this repeater hosts the Coshocton county amateur radio net.

This net provides a forum for amateurs to formulate and exchange ideas that foster the continued growth of amateur radio locally and world wide. Your club has available a great deal of expertise and dedicated amateurs willing to share their knowledge when requested. This is a directed net, and all participants will act only through net control. If you have anything to swap, buy or sell, you may list these items when you are called.

Since this repeater is usually connected to Echolink at the station of KB8HEA, we encourage check-ins through this system as well.

Net control tonight is (*your call*). My name is (*name*).

At this time we will accept checkins for the Coshocton County Amateur Radio Net.

Please call (*your call*) at this time. (Leave time after repeater drops for any Echolink check-ins.)

Closing the net:

(*your call*) wishes to thank all net participants and will now close the Coshocton County Amateur Radio net. This frequency is now returned to regular amateur use.

good evening. (*your call*) is now off and clear.

Take check-ins,

Take mobiles and portables FIRST, then call others on check-in list.

Stop every 5min or so and take additional check-ins.

We usually go through net list once and at end of list we ask for comments from anyone and late check-ins too.

Hearing no additional comments we close the net.
